Family size adjustment: For each person in excess of eight, add 8 percent of the four person base to the eight person limit. For example, the nine person limit for a family at 80% of median income is $(\$49,200 \times .08) + \$64,950 = \$68,900$. (Note: all income limits are rounded to the nearest \$50).
